LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, MIKE RILEY

## Climate, Justice & November: Vote Your Values Ballots will arrive around October 15th.

It's hard to imagine a more challenging or crisis filled year than 2020. And now, just when the pandemic was easing up a bit here in Oregon . . . FIRE! As I write, smoke blocks the sun and my nephew has just fled a rapidly growing wildfire in Paisley. The scenes of destruction are devastating, where the fires hit rural, low-income, and Latinx families especially hard.

**Make no mistake about it: these fires are being fueled by climate change.** Scientists have predicted more frequent and more intense droughts and severe weather events, exactly what produced these fires. But unlike a pandemic, there's no vaccine for climate

change. Just meaningful policy change at all levels of government and society.

The change that's needed starts right here at home: Re-shaping our energy system, making sure more people can get out of their cars to walk and bike safely, and making our region more equitable, inclusive and safe for people of color and vulnerable communities. We can't wait on DC or Salem.

**That's why I hope you will join me in voting for pro-environment and pro-justice candidates this fall.** We need to elect candidates who take climate change

and social justice seriously and who reflect the diversity of the communities they serve. Check out our list of resources to learn more about where local and statewide candidates stand on issues and how to vote in Oregon.

**In Bend, please vote YES on Bend's transportation bond, Measure 9-135. The Environmental Center endorses this measure** because it will, if passed, invest nearly \$60 million in safety, walking, biking and transit infrastructure over the next ten years—the biggest investment in non-auto transportation in our City's history. It will also improve traffic flow and east-west travel routes for drivers. While the measure is not perfect, it is a huge step in the right direction of reshaping Bend's transportation system. We have made some real progress in Bend these past several years. We adopted a climate action plan and we updated our transportation plan to place a higher priority on active transportation rather than just cars. And our City Council has begun the work to create a Human Rights and Equity Commission.

To sustain that progress, we need elected officials who share our pro-environment, pro-justice values. We need

elected officials who understand that we can't have one without the other. That won't happen unless all of us actively engage in this election. So be sure you're registered, get involved in a campaign or two (or even three), and don't forget to VOTE!

## EXPANDING RECYCLING EFFORTS

We received a grant to help improve recycling at multifamily housing complexes in Bend and Redmond. Our goal is to develop a set of best practices for other complexes in Deschutes County to follow. Little did we know that this year would bring extra challenges to an already challenging task! Due to COVID-19, we adapted our outreach and education strategies to make this project a reality. We moved from a door-to-door campaign to tabling on-site once per week. Instead of hosting summer camps with youth at the four complexes, we are developing supplemental school activities.

To date, **we've distributed 88 toolkits in two complexes**, which include:

- a reusable bag made from repurposed materials
- stickers showing what is recyclable for residents to put in the provided bins
- jars with recipes and an 'Eat First' basket to help reduce food waste
- a print copy of the Rethink Waste Guide (which is now also available in Spanish!)

In Redmond, we facilitated a few key changes to clean up the garbage and recycling enclosures. First, we provided more space for recyclables, doubling the recycling space from 360 gallons to 920 gallons per week. Then we created better signage to help residents navigate the bins and to make sorting an easier task.

As winter approaches, we will continue with recycling education and expand to the other two complexes!

## LOTS GROWIN' ON IN THE GARDEN



Using individual colanders, each kid could harvest, rinse, and eat their own lemon cucumbers.

Summer in the learning garden looked different this year, but kids still got their hands dirty - and washed them a lot - and grew and ate nutritious food. The biggest adaptation was preparing individual snacks instead of sharing meals. Each week's lesson focused on a different plant part. Students made a black bean dip (seeds), "ants on a log" (stems), lettuce wraps (leaves), a pollinator salad (fruits & flowers), and a final plant part salad (including roots). Yum!

Tracy Ryan, our former FoodCorps Service Member, has officially joined our team. This school year, she'll be in Three Rivers to continue supporting, building and utilizing their new outdoor garden. She also will be adapting our planned cafeteria tastings to a new COVID world when schools are back in person.
