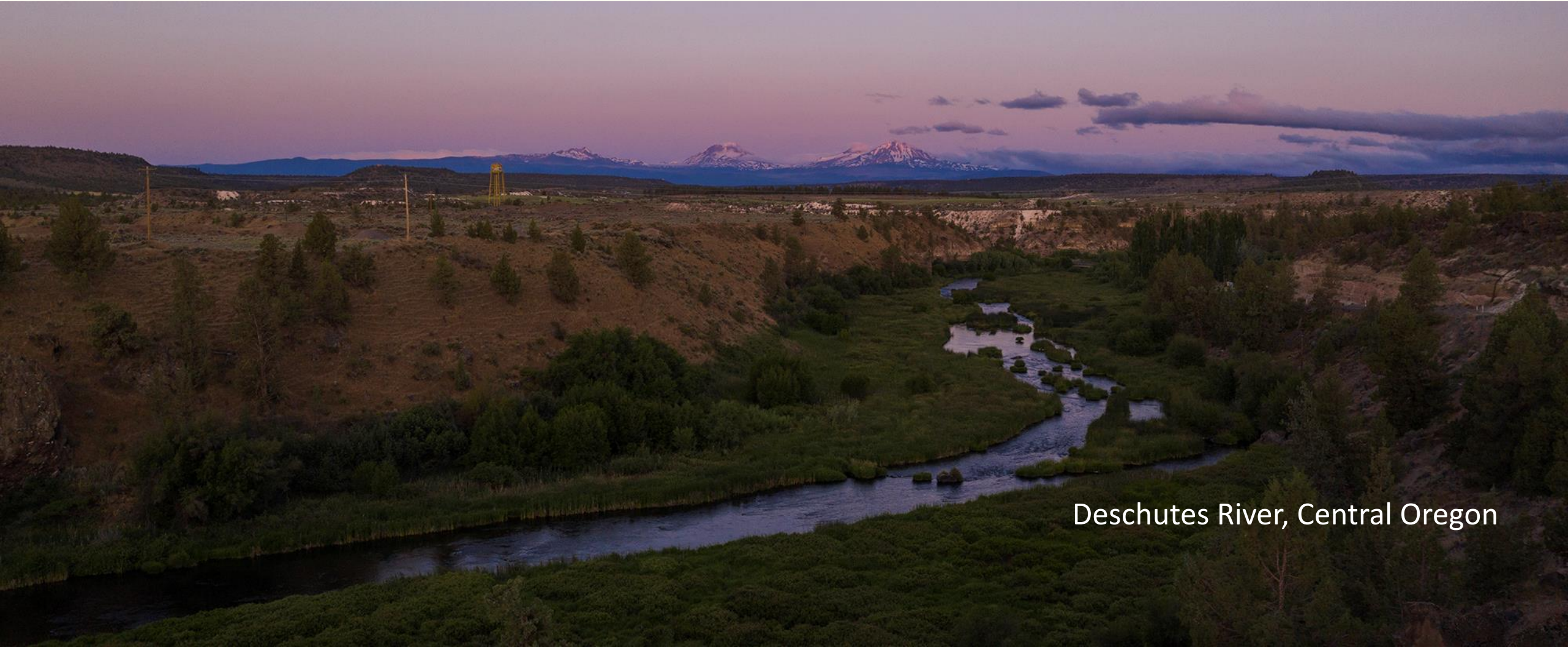
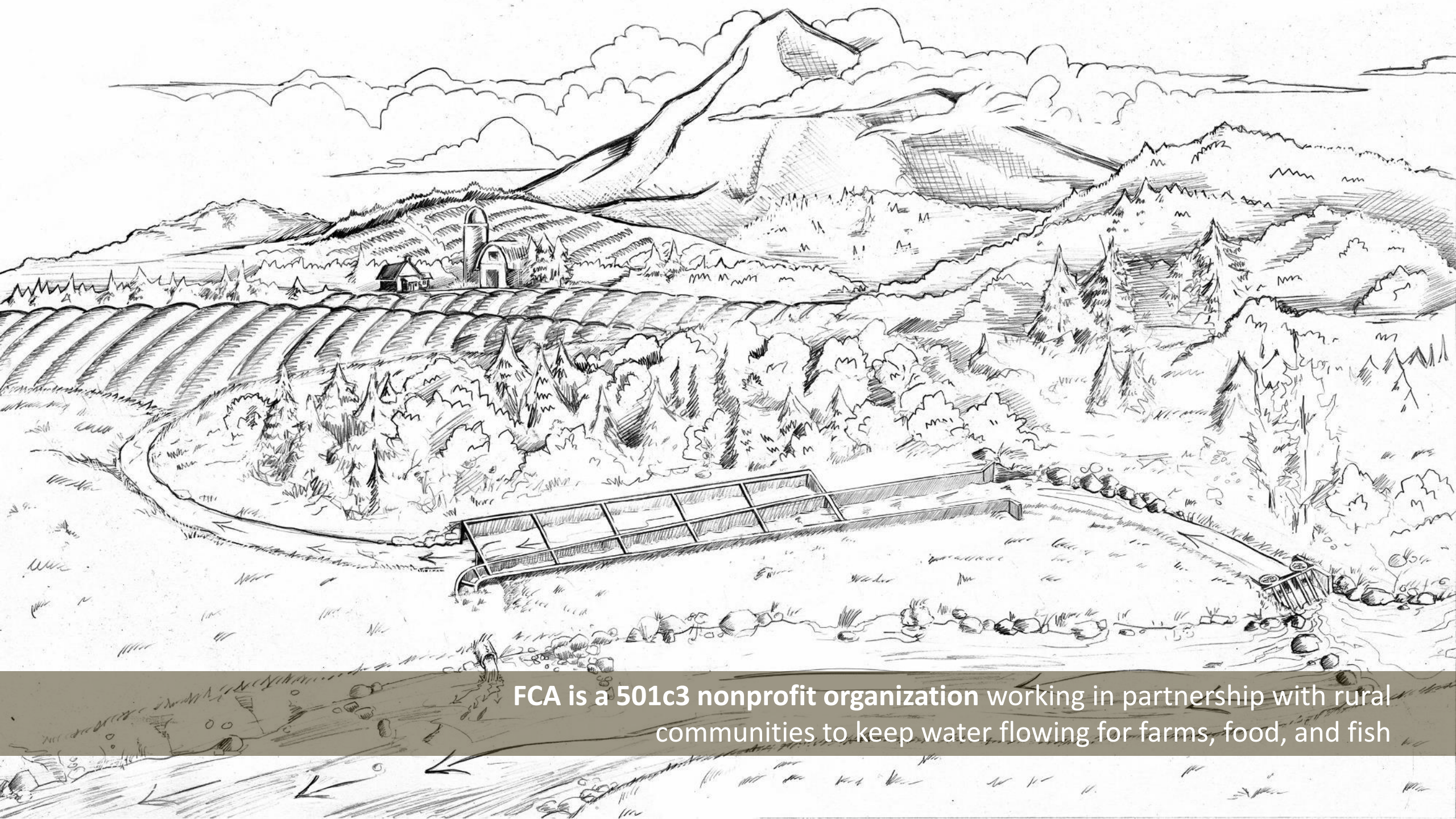

Deschutes River, Central Oregon

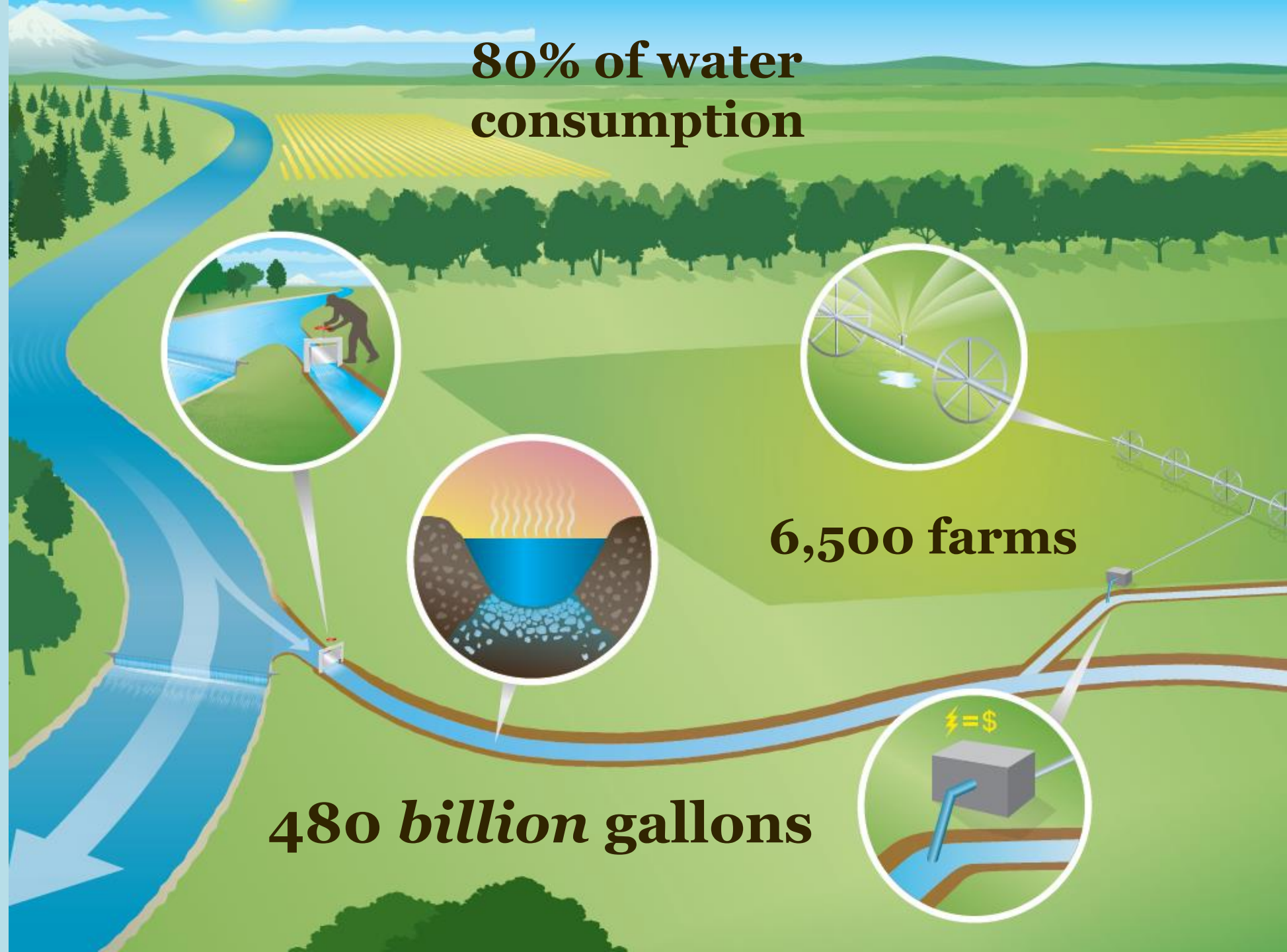

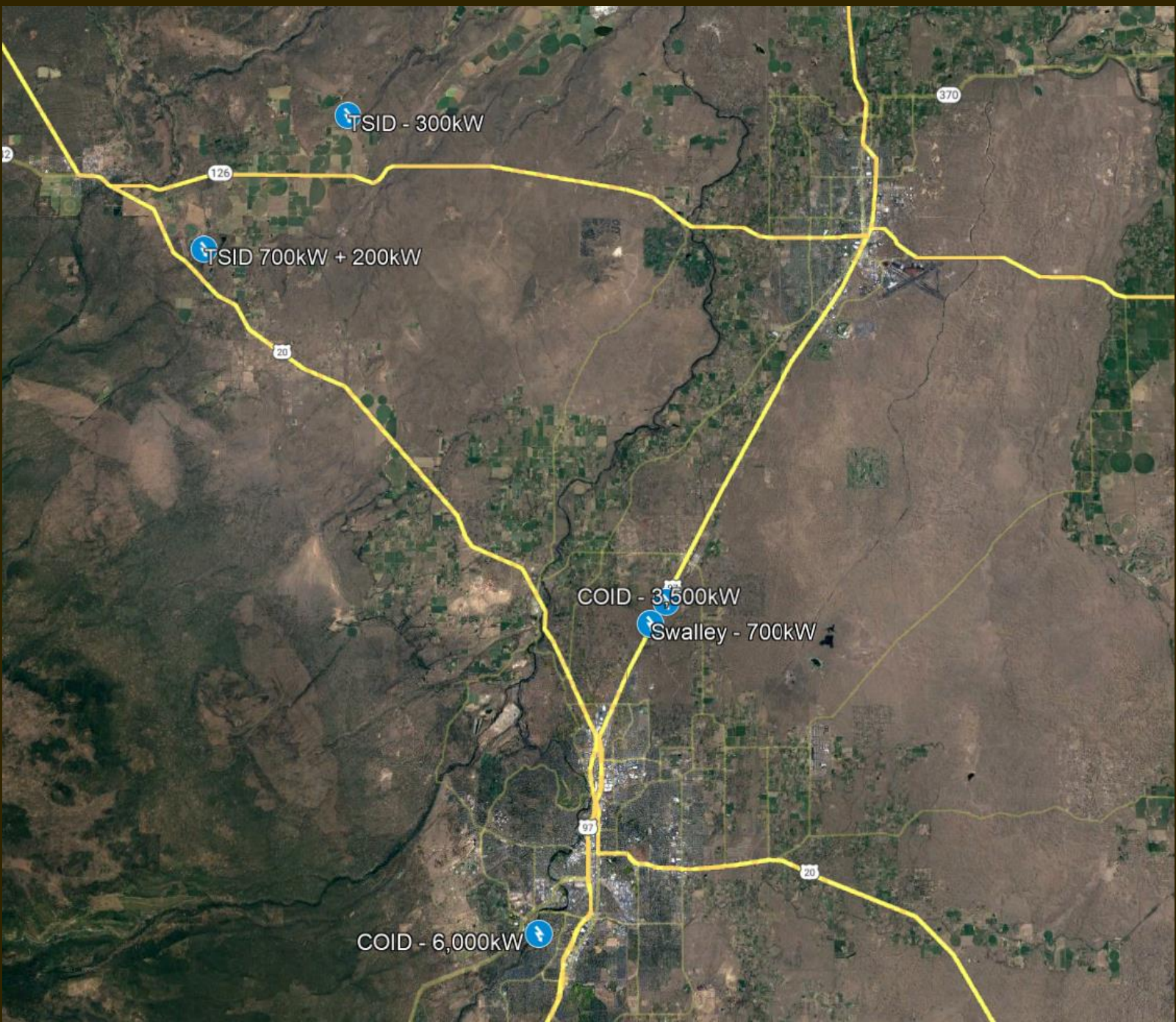
Modernized Irrigation

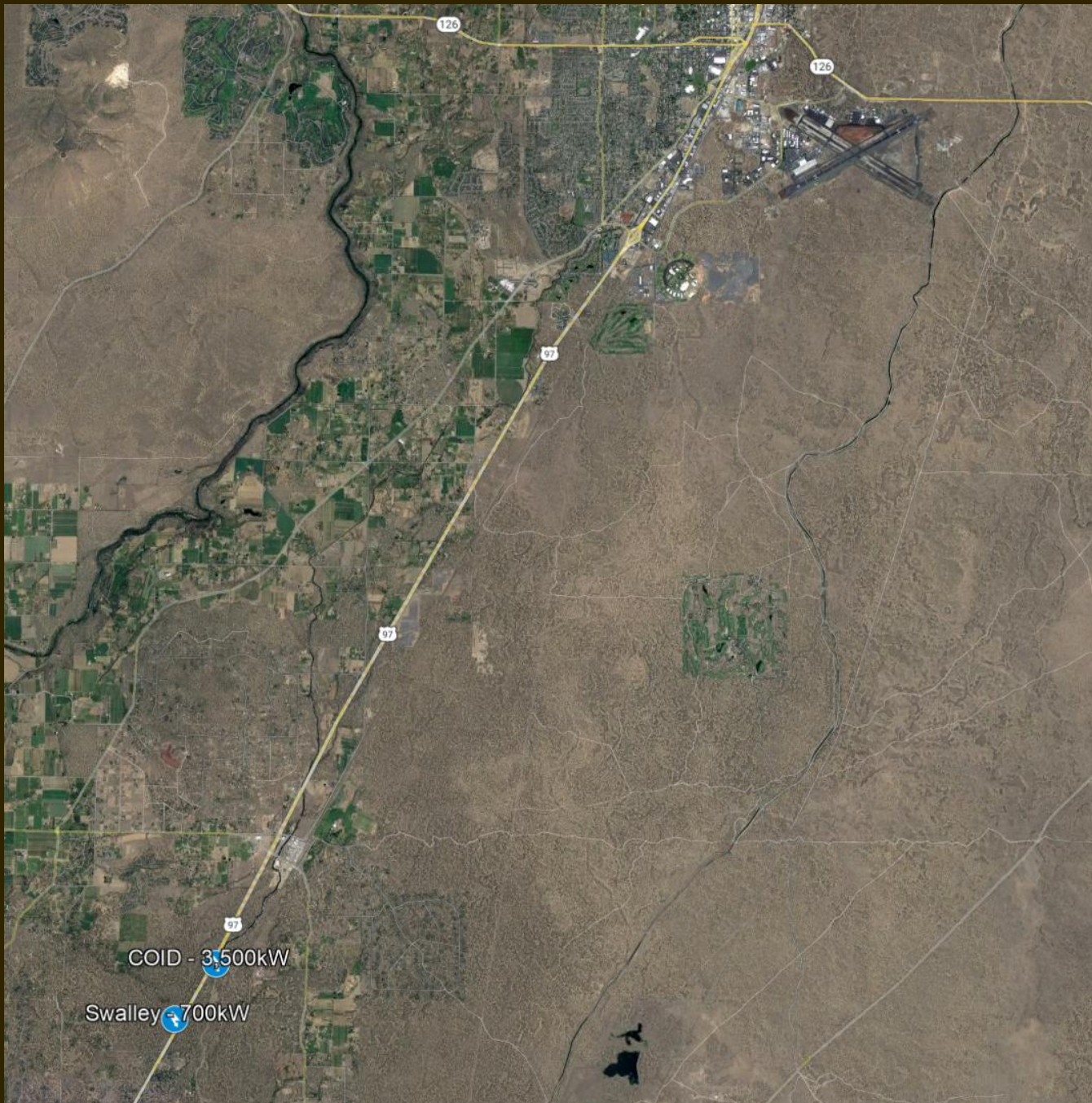
Over 11,000 kW of in-conduit and low impact hydropower in Central Oregon, with more possible.



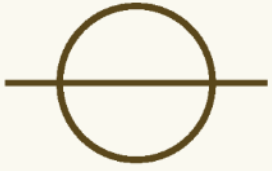
